**EMC engaged by Institute for Sustainable Communities**

EMC has been commissioned by the Institute for Sustainable Communities (ISC) to prepare **three** white papers outlining policy recommendations. The papers will be developed based on a review of policy instruments and learnings from other initiatives at the global level for effective mitigation of urban air pollution. Specific topics for these white papers are- 1. Building clean city air action plans on airshed basis instead of limiting to administrative boundaries 2. Including climate action in the formulation of city clean air action plans 3. Introducing innovative financing schemes for reduction of emissions from industrial clusters in the cities. Stakeholder consultations will be carried out in finalizing the white papers.

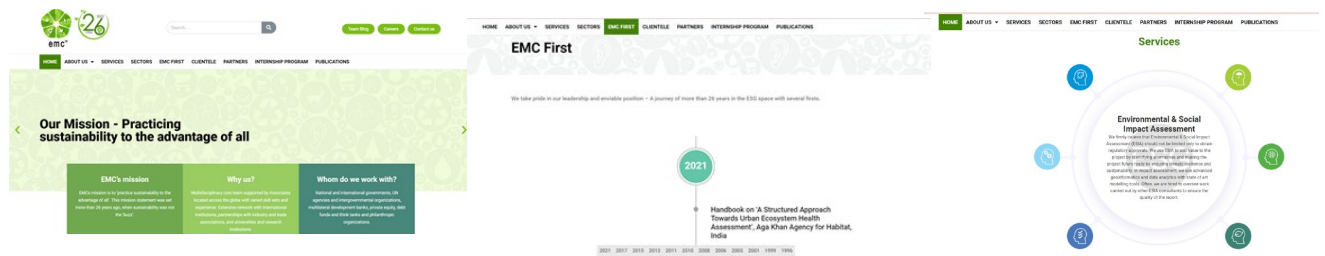
**Dr Modak delivered keynote address at the regional conference by ZDHC**
